**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 151-2019**

**To authorize the alteration of Winnett Avenue, between Durham Avenue and Arlington Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Winnett Avenue, between Durham Avenue and Arlington Avenue was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Winnett Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

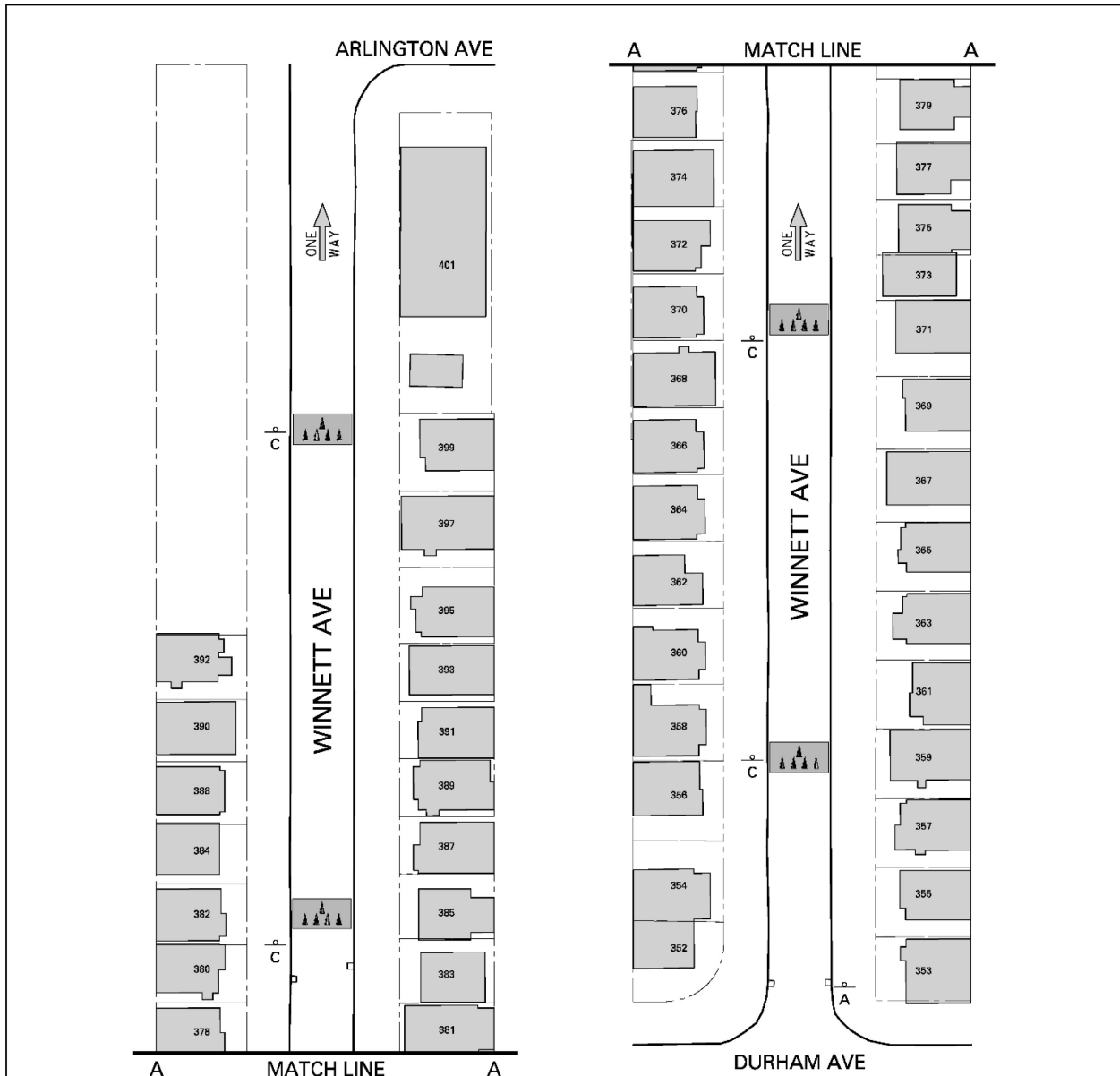
