BY-LAW 245-2019

To permanently close the public highway known as the lane at rear of 371 Bloor Street West and north of Washington Avenue, between Spadina Avenue and Huron Street.

Whereas it is recommended that the public lane at the rear of 371 Bloor Street West and north of Washington Avenue, between Spadina Avenue and Huron Street be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the public lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on January 15, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public lane at the rear of 371 Bloor Street West and north of Washington Avenue, between Spadina Avenue and Huron Street, legally described as follows, is permanently closed as a public highway:
