BY-LAW 322-2019

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Delaware Avenue North.

Whereas effective December 1, 2018, City Council adopted new Community Council boundaries to accommodate the new electoral wards and approved that where bills had previously been authorized by a Community Council decision made under delegated authority, these bills are now authorized to be submitted to and enacted by the Community Council having geographic jurisdiction for the matter;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| Delaware Avenue North | West | The public lane first north of Geary Avenue and Davenport Road | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. | 1 hour |
