BY-LAW 526-2019

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bathurst Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bathurst Street	West	A point 90.5 metres north of Nassau Street and Lennox Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
Bathurst Street	West	Robinson Street and Nassau Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bathurst Street	West	Robinson Street and Lennox Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

C. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bathurst Street	West	A point 90.5 metres north of Nassau Street and Lennox Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
Bathurst Street	West	Nassau Street and a point 90.5 metres north	Anytime
Bathurst Street	West	Richmond Street West and Nassau Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

D. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bathurst Street	West	Richmond Street West and Lennox Street	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
