BY-LAW 833-2019

To authorize the alteration of Delisle Avenue, between Yonge Street and Deer Park Crescent.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Delisle Avenue, between Yonge Street and Deer Park Crescent, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Delisle Avenue, between Yonge Street and Deer Park Crescent;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Delisle Avenue, between Yonge Street and Deer Park Crescent, by the installation of five speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing 421G-2452 dated March 2017 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
