BY-LAW 1015-2019

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Bridletowne Circle and Brookmill Boulevard.**

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Highway)

Bridletowne Circle (northeast leg)

Between)

Finch Avenue East (east intersection) and
Warden Avenue (north intersection)

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1
Highway)

Bridletowne Circle (northeast leg)

Bridletowne Circle (northeast leg)

(In Column 2
Between)

Finch Avenue East (east intersection) and
Brookmill Boulevard (south side)

Brookmill Boulevard (north side) and Warden
Avenue (north intersection)

- C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1
Intersection)

Bridletowne Circle and Brookmill Boulevard

Brookmill Boulevard and Bridletowne Circle

(In Column 2
Stop Street or Highway)

Bridletown Circle

Brookmill Boulevard
