BY-LAW 1081-2019

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Frater Avenue and Glebemount Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)
Glebemount Avenue	The north side of Sammon Avenue and the south side of Mortimer Avenue

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)
Glebemount Avenue	The north side of Sammon Avenue and the south side of Frater Avenue
Glebemount Avenue	The north side of Frater Avenue and the south side of Mortimer Avenue

- C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Frater Avenue and Glebemount Avenue	Frater Avenue
Glebemount Avenue and Frater Avenue	Glebemount Avenue
