BY-LAW 1262-2019

To authorize the alteration of Roxton Road, between Bloor Street West and Harbord Street by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Roxton Road, between Bloor Street West and Harbord Street, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Roxton Road, between Bloor Street West and Harbord Street;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

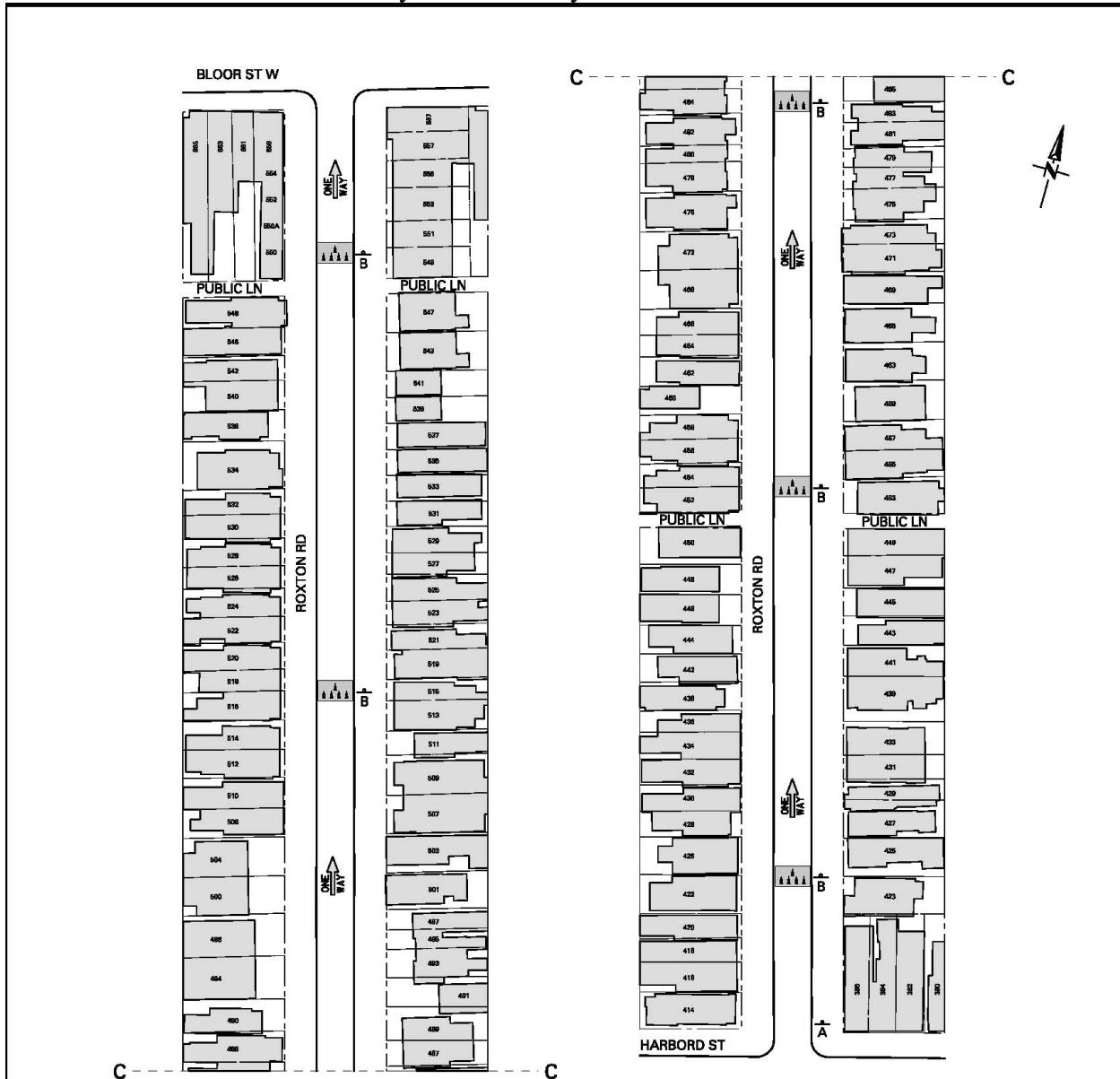
