BY-LAW 1263-2019

To authorize the alteration of Wells Street, between Bathurst Street and Kendal Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Wells Street, between Bathurst Street and Kendal Avenue, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Wells Street;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

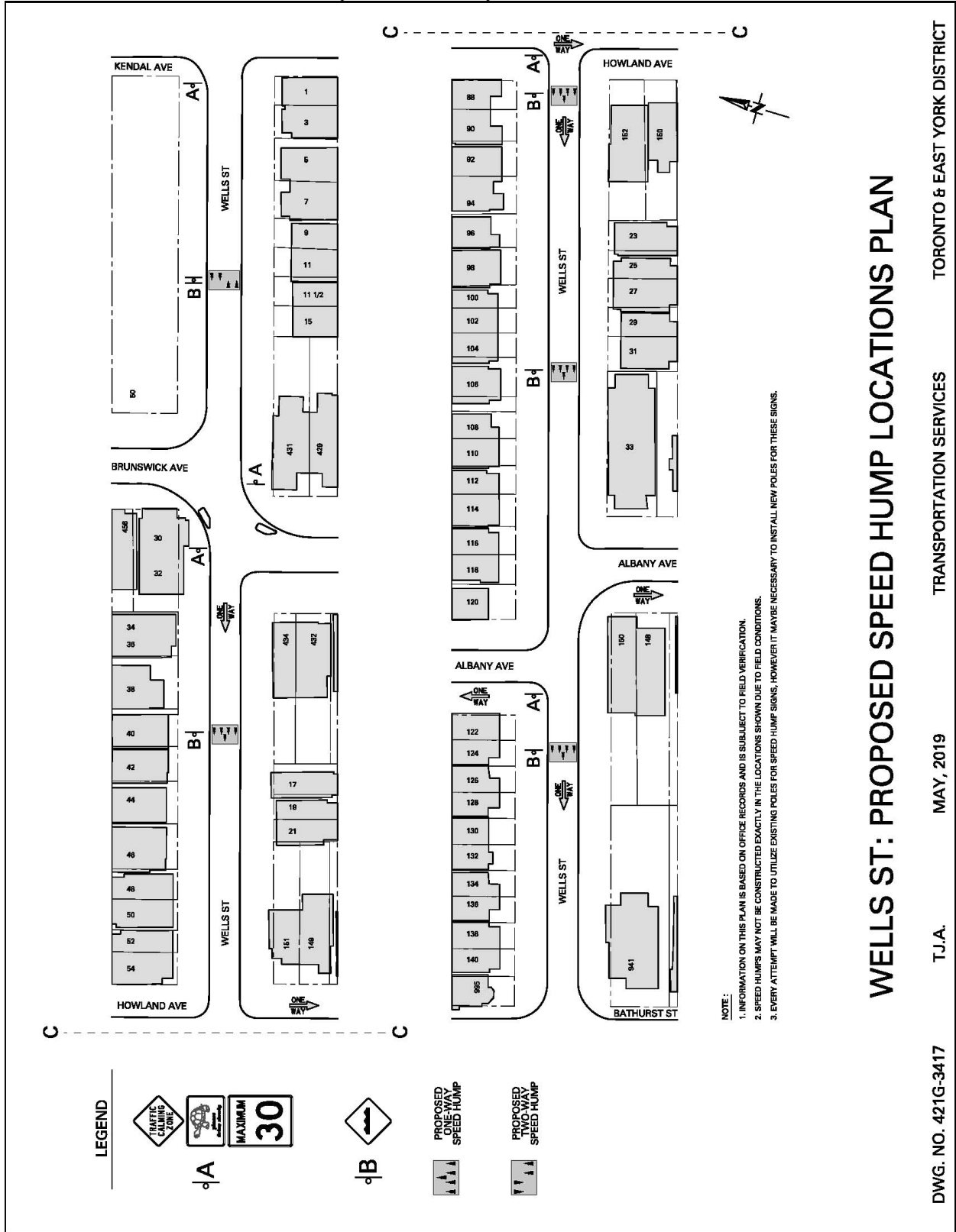
1. The alteration of Wells Street, between Bathurst Street and Kendal Avenue, by the installation of five speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing 421G-3417 dated May 2019 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
