## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 1273-2019

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Elm Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule VI (Commercial Loading Zones) in § 950-1305, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Elm Street	South	A point 32 metres east of Bay Street and a point 11.5 metres further east	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Elm Street	South	Bay Street and a point 56.4 metres east	Anytime
Elm Street	South	Yonge Street and Bay Street	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Elm Street	South	Bay Street and a point 32 metres east	Anytime

D. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Elm Street	South	Yonge Street and Bay Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat.	1 hour

E. By inserting in Schedule XVI (No Standing) in § 950-1315, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Elm Street(TO)	South	A point 43.5 metres east of Bay Street and a point 6 metres further east	Anytime
