BY-LAW 1290-2019

To authorize the naming of a public lane located east of Huron Street, extending south of Dundas Street West as Jean Lumb Lane.

Whereas pursuant to Section 27-18.4E(4) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;
