

## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 20-2020

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bertha Avenue and Nancy Avenue.

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Nancy Avenue	North	A point 73 metres east of Pharmacy Avenue and a point 45 metres further east	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Nancy Avenue	North	Pharmacy Avenue and Presley Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	30 mins.

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Nancy Avenue	North	A point 53 metres east of Pharmacy Avenue and a point 20 metres further east	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	30 mins.

D. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Nancy Avenue and Bertha Avenue	Nancy Avenue
