BY-LAW 125-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting George Street.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
George Street (YK)	East	A point 31 metres north of King Street and a point 43 metres further north	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
George Street	West	A point 31 metres north of King Street and a point 82 metres further north	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	5 mins.

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
George Street	West	A point 74 metres north of King Street and a point 39 metres further north	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	5 mins.

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
George Street (YK), and the private driveway 23 George Street, located on the east side of George Street, approximately 85 metres north of King Street	Southbound	Left	Anytime
George Street (YK), and the private driveway 30 George Street, located on the west side of George Street, approximately 20 metres north of King Street	Northbound	Left	Anytime
