BY-LAW 158-2020

To authorize the alteration of Brunswick Avenue, between Dupont Street and Wells Street, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Brunswick Avenue, between Dupont Street and Wells Street, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Brunswick Avenue, between Dupont Street and Wells Street;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Brunswick Avenue, between Dupont Street and Wells Street, by the installation of five speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-3080, dated June 2018 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
