BY-LAW 211-2020

To permanently close to vehicular traffic a portion of westbound Fleet Street, between Bathurst Street and Iannuzzi Street.

Whereas it is recommended that a portion of westbound Fleet Street, between Bathurst Street and Iannuzzi Street, as shown in Attachment 1 to the report (June 17, 2019) of Toronto and East York Community Council Item TE7.123, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on July 16, 17 and 18, 2019, be permanently closed to vehicular traffic; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close to vehicular traffic the said portion of public highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on June 25, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Fleet Street, legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

PART OF PIN 21418-0085 (LT)
PART OF FLEET STREET, PLAN D1444 TORONTO,
DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 66R-31155; CITY OF TORONTO

2. Part of the public highway known as Bathurst Street, legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

PART OF PIN 21418-0107 (LT)
PART OF BATHURST STREET, PLAN D1397 TORONTO,
DESIGNATED AS PART 4 ON PLAN 66R-31155; CITY OF TORONTO

3. Part of the public highway known as Iannuzzi Street, legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

PART OF PIN 21418-0180 (LT)
PART OF BLOCK A, PLAN D1444,
DESIGNATED AS PART 2 ON PLAN 66R-31155; CITY OF TORONTO
