BY-LAW 287-2020

To authorize the alteration of Glenwood Crescent, between Glenwood Terrace and St. Columba Place, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Glenwood Crescent, between Glenwood Terrace and St. Columba Place was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Glenwood Crescent, between Glenwood Terrace and St. Columba Place;

Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Glenwood Crescent, between Glenwood Terrace and St. Columba Place, by the installation of four speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-2296, dated October 2016 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
