BY-LAW 325-2020

To provide for an integrated pest management plan to control European Gypsy Moth infestation.

Whereas the presence of European Gypsy Moth populations in certain areas of the City has reached outbreak levels; and

Whereas in the interest of preserving the environmental well-being of the City it is necessary to implement control measures in order to prevent further tree loss and defoliation and to preserve the tree canopy;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The General Manager, Parks Forestry and Recreation is authorized to implement an integrated pest management plan to control European Gypsy Moth infestation in Ward 2, including Aerial and ground spraying of the biological control agent *Bacillus thuringiensis* subspecies *kurstaki* (Btk) (Product Name: Foray 48B Biological Insecticide Aqueous Suspension - (PCP) Registration Number: 24977) in those areas identified on the map attached as Schedule A to this by-law.


