BY-LAW 860-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting South Station Street.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
South Station Street	West	Lawrence Avenue West and a point 87 metres north	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
South Station Street	West	A point 155.2 metres north of Lawrence Avenue West and a point 14 metres further north	Anytime

C. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
South Station Street	Both	Lawrence Avenue West and John Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat., except public holidays	2 hours

D. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
South Station Street	East	Lawrence Avenue West and John Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat., except public holidays	2 hours
South Station Street	West	A point 87 metres north of Lawrence Avenue West and a point 68.2 metres further north	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat., except public holidays	2 hours
South Station Street	West	A point 169.2 metres north of Lawrence Avenue West and John Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat., except public holidays	2 hours
