BY-LAW 963-2020

To confirm the proceedings of General Government and Licensing Committee at Meeting 17 held on November 2, 2020 as it relates to decisions made under delegated authority.

The General Government and Licensing Committee enacts:

1. The action of the General Government and Licensing Committee on November 2, 2020, taken under the delegated authority of Section 27-16.2C(2)(a) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, in respect of Items 17.1 and 17.2 of the General Government and Licensing Committee from its meeting on November 2, 2020 and in respect of Item 18.1, up to and including the enactment of this Confirmatory By-law at the conclusion of its Special meeting at 12:32 p.m. this day, and in respect of each motion, resolution and other action, passed and taken under delegated authority including the enactment of any previous Confirmatory By-laws in respect of the November 2 and 4, 2020 meetings, are adopted, ratified and confirmed.
2. The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, the City Clerk and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the City's seal to the documents.
3. This By-law, to the extent to which it provides authority for or constitutes the exercise by the General Government and Licensing Committee of its powers to proceed with, or to provide any money for, any undertaking, work, project, scheme, act, matter or thing which requires an approval in addition to the approval of the General Government and Licensing Committee, shall not take effect until the additional approval has been obtained.
