**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 1035-2020**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Lansdowne Avenue at Whytock Avenue and at a point approximately 300 metres south of Bloor Street West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Pedestrian Crossovers) in § 950-1337, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

At a point approximately 300 metres south of

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
