## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 1084-2020**

**To repeal By-law 992-2020, being a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Melville Avenue.**

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council, at its meeting held on November 10, 2020 deferred consideration of Item TE20.32 entitled "Parking Amendments – Melville Avenue, between Shaw Street and Christie Street" to its meeting scheduled to be held in January, 2020; and

Whereas By-law 992-2020, being a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Melville Avenue was enacted in error by Toronto and East York Community Council on November 10, 2020 with respect to deferred Item TE20.32; and

Whereas Section 169-5.2A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City authorizes the City Solicitor to process by-laws where an action is authorized by Council and if the recommendation to amend a by-law or introduce a bill has been omitted or if there is an error in the reference to the by-law that should be amended or if it is necessary to repeal a by-law;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts as follows:

1. By-law 992-2020 is repealed.
2. This By-law shall be effective commencing November 10, 2020.
