BY-LAW 1106-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Briar Hill Avenue.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Briar Hill Avenue	South	Dufferin Street and Marlee Avenue	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Briar Hill Avenue	North	A point 74 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 11 metres further east	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
Briar Hill Avenue	South	Dufferin Street and a point 85 metres east	Anytime
Briar Hill Avenue	South	A point 155 metres east of Dufferin Street and Marlee Avenue	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Briar Hill Avenue	Both	A point 85 metres east of Dufferin Street and a point 70 metres further east	Anytime
