BY-LAW 28-2021

To assume municipal services located in and on the extension of Sudbury Street (from Queen Street West to Abell Street).

Whereas the City has entered into a Section 37 Agreement and a Core Servicing Agreement with West Queen West Triangle Landowners Group Limited to provide for the public highways and municipal services on the extension of Sudbury Street and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City of Toronto's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Section 37 Agreement and the Core Servicing Agreement;
