BY-LAW 42-2021

To amend By-law 226-2020, being a by-law to exempt lands known municipally in the year 2019 as 117, 121, 123, and 129 Roselawn Avenue from part lot control, with respect to the correction of a technical error.

Whereas authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

Whereas the authority under North York Community Council Item NY11.2, as adopted by the City of Toronto Council on December 17 and 18, 2019, recommended the by-law expires two years from the date of enactment by Council; and

Whereas By-law 226-2020, enacted on February 26, 2020, originally expired one year from the date of its enactment by Council; and

Whereas this technical amending by-law is being passed to correct the expiry of By-law 226-2020 to bring it in line with the recommendations of Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto hereby enacts:

1. Section 2 of By-law 226-2020 is amended to read as follows:
 2. This By-law expires two years from the date of its enactment by Council.
