

CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 43-2021

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, and to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, to delegate to the General Manager of Transportation Services the authority to temporarily close highways to pedestrian and vehicular traffic up to and including 365 consecutive days but ending no later than December 31, 2030 for the purpose of the construction of the Ontario Line and the construction of the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Subsection 27-18.4B(6)(b) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, is amended by deleting the word "or" between "937-3.13" and "937-3.15" and adding the phrase ", 937-3.16 or 937-3.17" so that it reads as follows:

"The authority to deal with the matters set out in Subsection B(6)(a) only applies where the authority to temporarily close has not been delegated to the General Manager of Transportation Services pursuant to Sections 937-3.2, 937-3.8, 937-3.9, 937-3.13, 937-3.15, 937-3.16 or 937-3.17 of Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways."

2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended as follows:

- a. By inserting a new Section 937-3.16 as follows:

"§ 937-3.16. Ontario Line excluding the proposed above ground section of the Ontario Line between the Don River and Gerrard Street.

Despite any other by-law, until December 31, 2030 inclusive, the General Manager of Transportation Services may temporarily close to pedestrian and vehicular traffic highways or portions of highways for a period up to and including 365 consecutive days but ending no later than December 31, 2030, inclusive, as required for the purpose of the construction of Ontario Line excluding the proposed above ground section of the Ontario Line between Don River and Gerrard Street."

- b. By inserting a new Section 937-3.17 as follows:

"§ 937-3.17. Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.

Despite any other by-law, until December 31, 2030 inclusive, the General Manager of Transportation Services may temporarily close to pedestrian and vehicular traffic highways or portions of highways for a period up to and including 365 consecutive days but ending no later than December 31, 2030,

inclusive, as required for the purpose of the construction of Eglinton Crosstown West Extension."

- c. By amending section 937-4 by deleting the phrase "and 937-3.15" and inserting the phrase:

", 937-3.15, 937-3.16 and 937-3.17".
