BY-LAW 191-2021

To permanently close part of the public highway known as Randolph Avenue.

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known as Randolph Avenue, Toronto be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on February 24, 2021;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Randolph Avenue, and described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 21328-0540 (LT)

Part of Parcel 215, Section Township of York, Part of Maude Avenue,
Plan M23 Toronto lying west of Churchill Avenue, designated as Part 20 on
Plan 66R-31423; Toronto; City of Toronto.
