## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 320-2021

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, respecting Shaw Street, to amend a technical error.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting of January 12, 2021 authorized the extension of overnight on-street permit parking hours on Shaw Street, between Dewson Street and Harbord Street from 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days a week; and

Whereas By-law 12-2021, being a by-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, respecting Shaw Street", enacted by Toronto and East York Community Council on January 12, 2021 inadvertently inserted into Schedule A (Permit Parking) an entry for "Street Street" instead of for "Shaw Street"; and

Whereas Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, authorizes the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, to submit bills directly to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

**1. Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, is amended as follows:**

**A. By deleting from Schedule A (Permit Parking) the following in alphabetical order by street name:**

(From Column 1 Street)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Location)	(From Column 4 Period)	(From Column 5 Time)
Street Street	Even	Dewson Street and Harbord Street	All Times	12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**B. By inserting in Schedule A (Permit Parking) the following in alphabetical order by street name:**

(In Column 1 Street)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Period)	(In Column 5 Time)
Shaw Street	Even	Dewson Street and Harbord Street	All times	12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
