BY-LAW 463-2021

To permanently close a portion of the public highway at the intersection of Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard

Whereas it is recommended that a portion of the public highway at the south-west corner of the intersection of Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard in the City of Toronto, legally described as Part of Lot 26 Concession A Fronting the Humber, Geographic Township of Etobicoke and designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 66R-31056, be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, and the Etobicoke York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on May 17, 2021;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. A portion of the public highway at the south-west corner of the intersection of Islington Avenue and Rexdale Boulevard in the City of Toronto, described as follows, is hereby permanently close as public highway:

Part of PIN 07335-0093 (LT)

Part of Lot 26 Concession A Fronting the Humber, Geographic Township of Etobicoke, City of Toronto, designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-31056.

And

Part of PIN 07334-0226 (LT)

Part of Lot 26 Concession A Fronting the Humber, Geographic Township of Etobicoke, City of Toronto, designated as Part 2 on Reference Plan 66R-31056
