BY-LAW 484-2021

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to clarify the standards for swimming pool enclosures.

Whereas under section 8 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may pass by-laws in respect of the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City, the health, safety and well-being of persons and structures including fences; and

Whereas Council has authorized amendments to clarify the standards for swimming pool enclosures in the City;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Subsections 447-1.3E(2)(b)[1][b] and [c] of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, are amended so they read as follows:
 - [b] Spaced not more than 38 millimetres apart where horizontal rails are spaced less than 1.2 metres apart;
 - [c] Spaced not more than 100 millimetres apart where horizontal rails are spaced 1.2 metres apart or more;
