## **BY-LAW 676-2021**

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, and Chapter 636, Public Squares;

To repeal City of Toronto By-laws 322-2020 and 323-2020, as amended by City of Toronto By-law 342-2020, City of Toronto By-law 666-2020 (as amended by City of Toronto By-law 912-2020), City of Toronto By-law 845-2020, City of Toronto By-law 58-2021 and City of Toronto By-law 483-2021; and

To delete Section 545-8.4.1. COVID-19 measures of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Sections 608-3.A(1.1), 608-3.F and 608-3.G of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, are deleted.
- **2.** Sections 636-11.C, 636-11.C.1, 636-22.A.(4), 636-22.C.1 and 636-22.C.2 of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 636, Public Squares, are deleted.
- **3.** Section 636-19 is amended by adding the following § 636-19.D:
  - D. A person engaged in location filming during a period and at a place as have been first approved in a permit issued by the City's Film Liaison with the approval of the Yonge-Dundas Board of Management if the activities under the permit are carried on, engaged in or done during the period and at the place and in a manner consistent with the permit.
- 4. City of Toronto By-law 322-2020 is repealed.
- 5. City of Toronto By-law 323-2020 is repealed.
- 6. Section 545-8.4.1. COVID-19 measures of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is deleted.
