## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 677-2021**

**To make technical amendments to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693, Signs, with respect to election signs.**

Whereas it is necessary to amend Chapter 693, Signs, with respect to election signs to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 693-6 of Article II, Election Signs of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693 is amended by adding the following new subsections and re-lettering the subsequent subsections accordingly:
  - E. The election sign interferes with the safe operation of motor vehicular traffic, or the safety of cyclists or pedestrians;
  - F. The election sign obstructs visibility or blocks sightlines by impeding a pedestrian's or driver's view of an intersection or a vehicular access point;
  - G. The election sign is attached to a tree;
2. Section 693-7A(1) of Article II, Election Signs of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693 is amended by deleting subparagraphs (b) and (c) and re-lettering the subsequent subparagraphs accordingly.
3. This By-law comes into force on the day it is enacted and passed.
