

**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 875-2021**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Hazelton Avenue.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule VI (Commercial Loading Zones) in § 950-1305, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Hazelton Avenue	East	Davenport Road and a point 34 metres south	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

B. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Hazelton Avenue	East	Davenport Road and a point 23 metres south	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Hazelton Avenue	East	A point 34 metres south of Davenport and a point 10 metres further south.	Anytime

D. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Hazelton Avenue	East	A point 65.5 metres north of Scollard Street and Davenport Road	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	1 hour

E. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Hazelton Avenue	East	A point 65.5 metres north of Scollard Street and a point 49.5 metres south of Davenport Road	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	1 hour
