BY-LAW 922-2021

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Commissioners Street, Saulters Street South and Villiers Street.

The Council of The City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Villiers Street (south branch)	South	Cherry Street and a point 29 metres east of Munition Street	Anytime
Villiers Street (south branch)	South	Don Roadway and a point 30 metres west	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Villiers Street	South	Cherry Street and Don Roadway	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Commissioners Street	Saulter Street South and a point 30.5 metres east	Northerly Westbound	Anytime	Westbound right-turning (buses excepted)

D. By deleting from Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection)	(From Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Saulter Street South and Commissioners Street	Saulter Street South
