BY-LAW 984-2021

To authorize the alteration of Wallace Avenue, between Dufferin Street and Lansdowne Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council waived the petition and polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Wallace Avenue, between Dufferin Street and Lansdowne Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

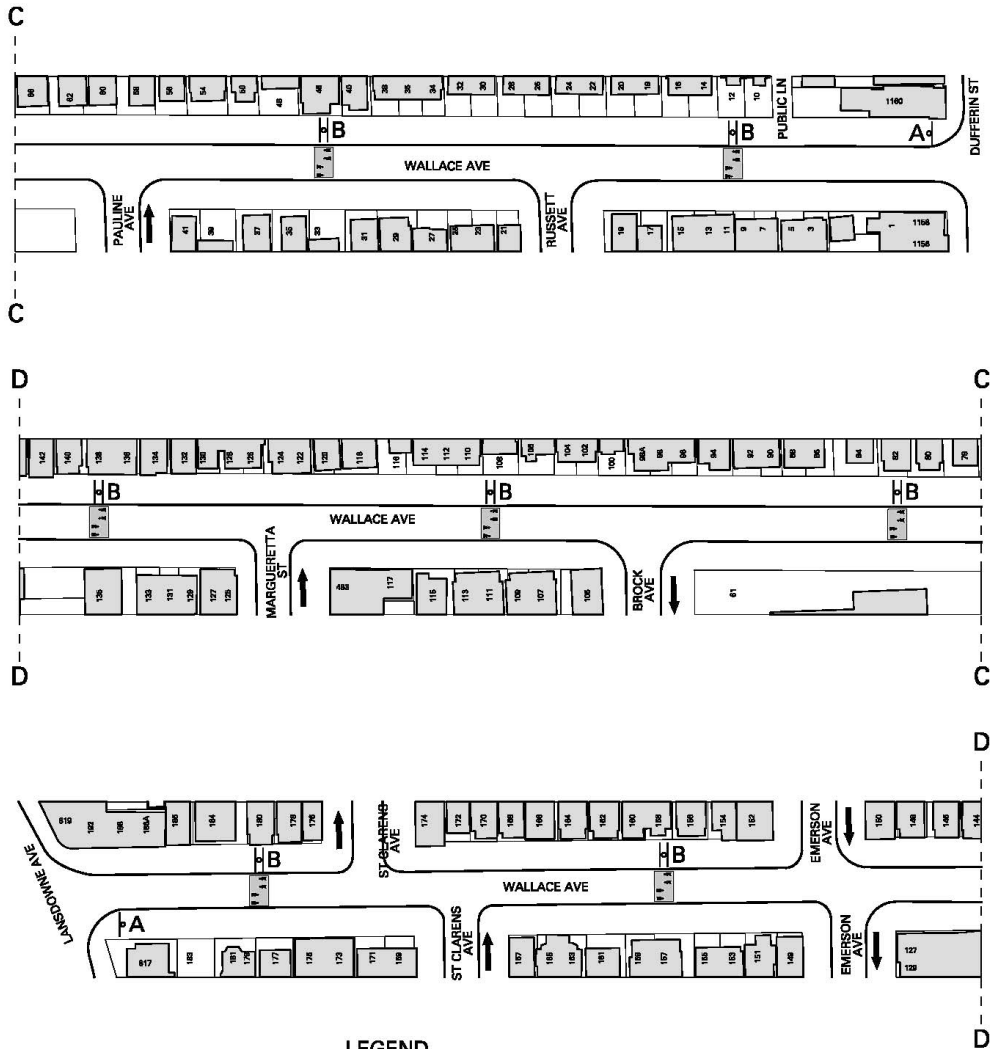
1. The alteration of Wallace Avenue, between Dufferin Street and Lansdowne Avenue, by the installation of seven speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-3694 dated February 2020 attached to this By-law, is authorized.

Enacted and passed on November 24, 2021.

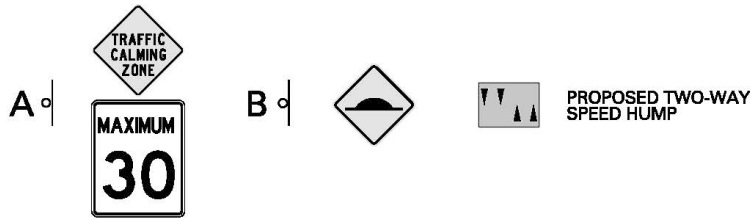
