

**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 1011-2021**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Parliament Street and Trinity Street.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Parliament Street	Both	Lake Shore Boulevard East and Mill Street	Anytime from and including Wed. Nov. 24, 2021 to and including Fri. Dec. 31, 2021

B. By inserting in Schedule XVI (No Standing) in § 950-1315, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Trinity Street	East	Front Street East and 38 metres south of Front Street East	Anytime from and including Wed. Nov. 24, 2021 to and including Fri. Dec. 31, 2021

C. By inserting a new Subsection (6) in § 950-1202A as follows:

"(6) During the time frame indicated in the entry in Subsection 1A to 1B, inclusive, of By-law 1011-2021, the provisions of Subsections 1A to 1B of By-law 1011-2021 shall apply notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other by-law or chapter of the Municipal Code. For further clarity, where any regulation contained in Subsection 1A to 1B, inclusive, of By-law 1011-2021 conflicts with any other regulation in any Schedule of Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and

Parking, the regulation as found in By-law 1011-2021 shall prevail during the time frame outlined in the regulation as found in By-law 1011-2021."
