BY-LAW 1097-2021

To permanently close the east-west part of the public highway known as Guest Avenue.

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known as Guest Avenue, Toronto be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on November 24, 2021;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Guest Avenue, Toronto, and described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 21013-0250

Part of Lot 11, Plan 666 Toronto (East Toronto) being Part 7 on Reference Plan 63R-1144; Part of Lot 12 Plan 666 Toronto (East Toronto) being Parts 8 and 9 on Reference Plan 63R-1144; Part of Lot 3 Concession 1 From the Bay Township of York being Part 1 on Reference Plan 63R-4418; Part of Lanes Plan 666 Toronto (East Toronto) begin Guest Avenue between Danforth Avenue and Dawes Road; designated as Parts 1 and 17 on Plan 66R-32280 Toronto, City of Toronto.

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not take effect until the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer, by the City of Toronto as transferor, of the land described in Section 1 of this By-law.
