BY-LAW 10-2022

To authorize the alteration of Roseheath Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Hanson Street, by the installation of speed humps.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

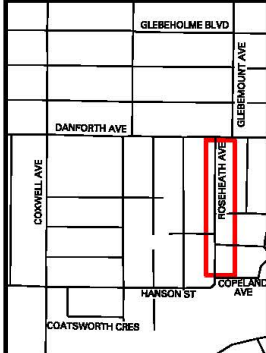
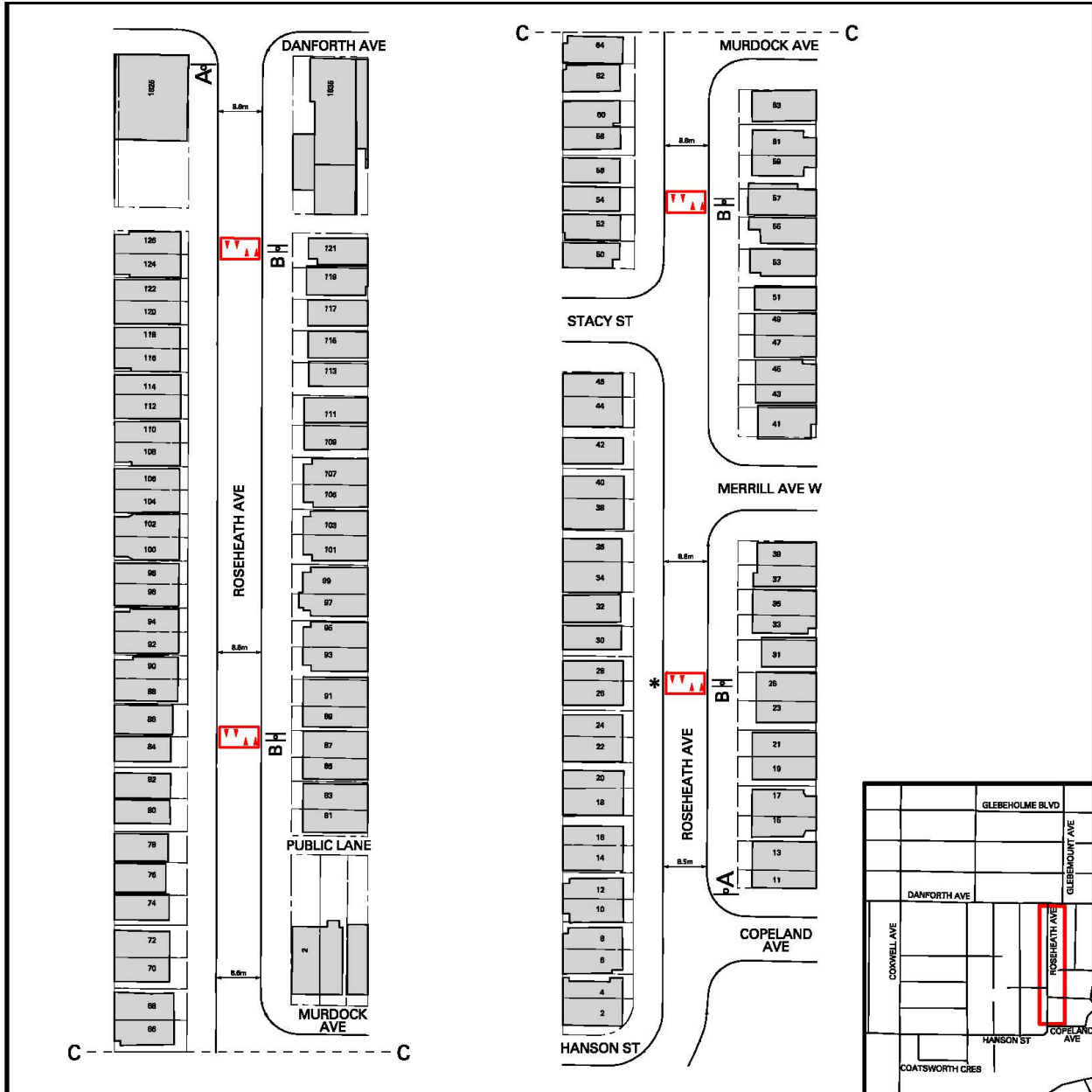
