BY-LAW 11-2022

To authorize the alteration of Drayton Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and the south end of Drayton Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Drayton Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and the south end of Drayton Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

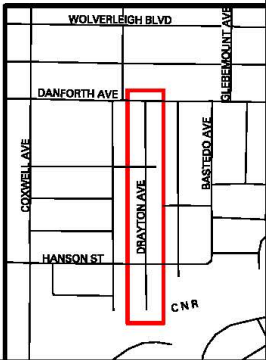
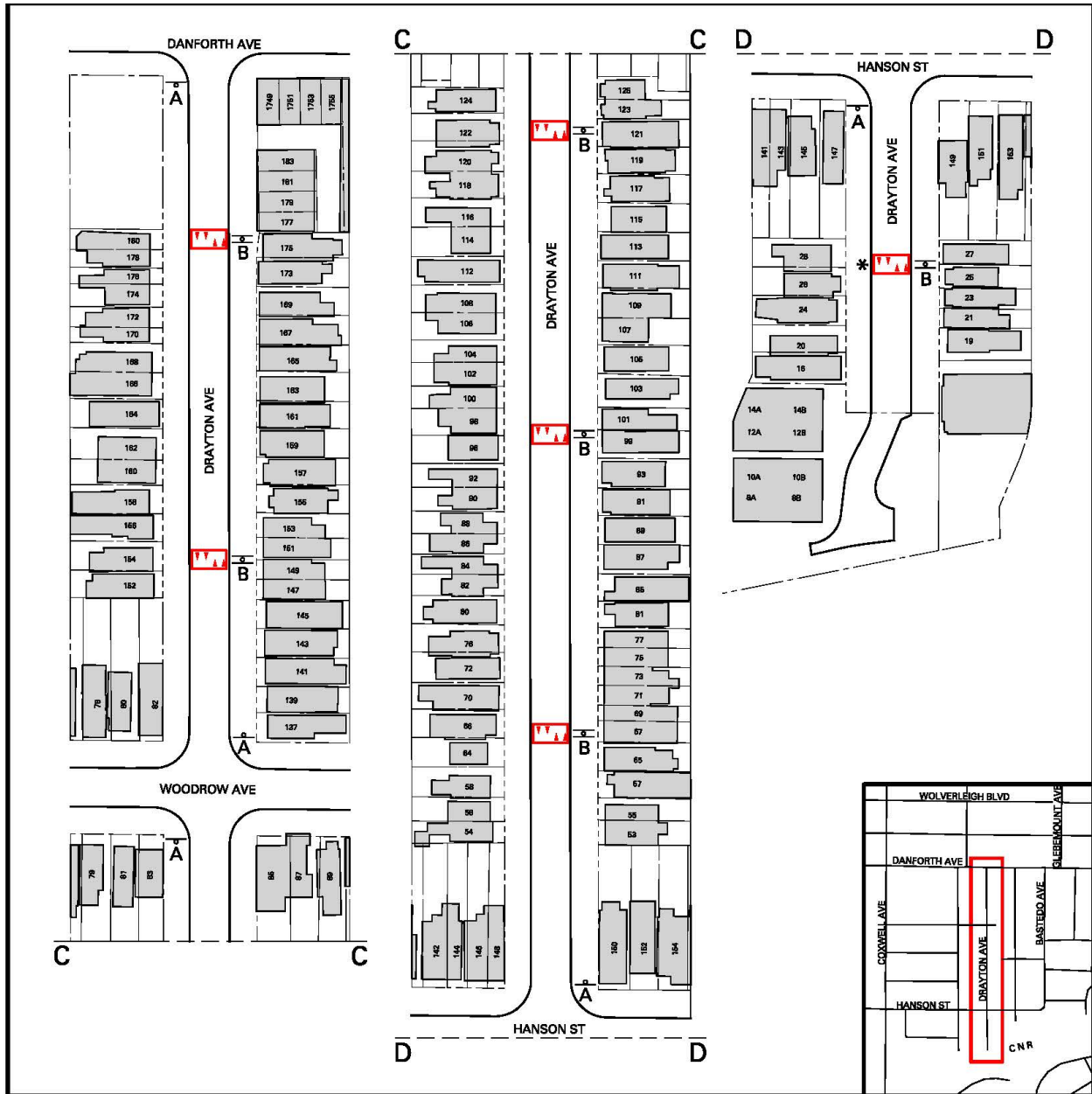
