BY-LAW 13-2022

To authorize the alteration of Nursewood Road, between Queen Street East and the south end of Nursewood Road, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Nursewood Road, between Queen Street East and the south end of Nursewood Road, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

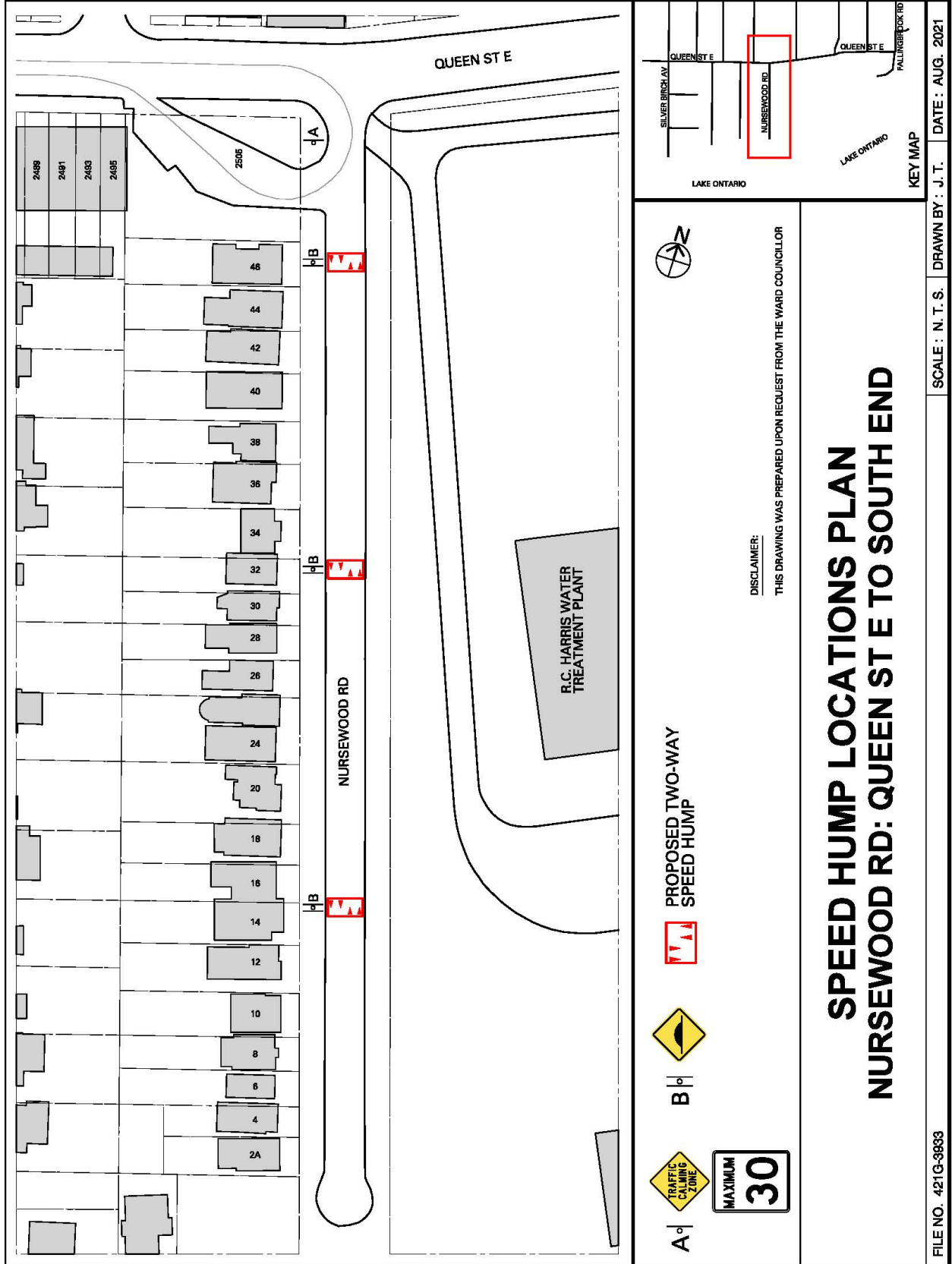
