

## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 299-2022

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Palmerston Avenue and Tecumseth Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Palmerston Avenue	Barton Avenue and Palmerston Square (north leg)	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Palmerston Avenue	A point 45.9 metres south of College Street and a point 42 metres north of Dundas Street West	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Palmerston Avenue	A point 54 metres north of Robinson Street and Dundas Street West	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Palmerston Avenue	Bloor Street West and London Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Palmerston Avenue	Queen Street West and Robinson Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Tecumseth Street	Queen Street West and a point 37 metres south	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Tecumseth Street	King Street West and Tecumseth Place (north leg)	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Tecumseth Street	Queen Street West and a point 37 metres south	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
