To authorize the alteration of Harlton Crescent at 30 Harlton Crescent by the installation of a speed hump.

Whereas Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of a speed hump at 30 Harlton Crescent and waived the petition and polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Harlton Crescent at 30 Harlton Crescent, by the installation of one speed hump, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-3921 dated August 2021 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
