The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

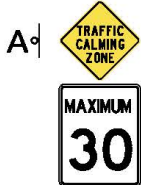
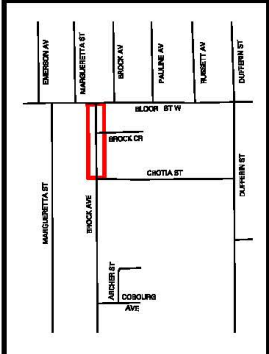
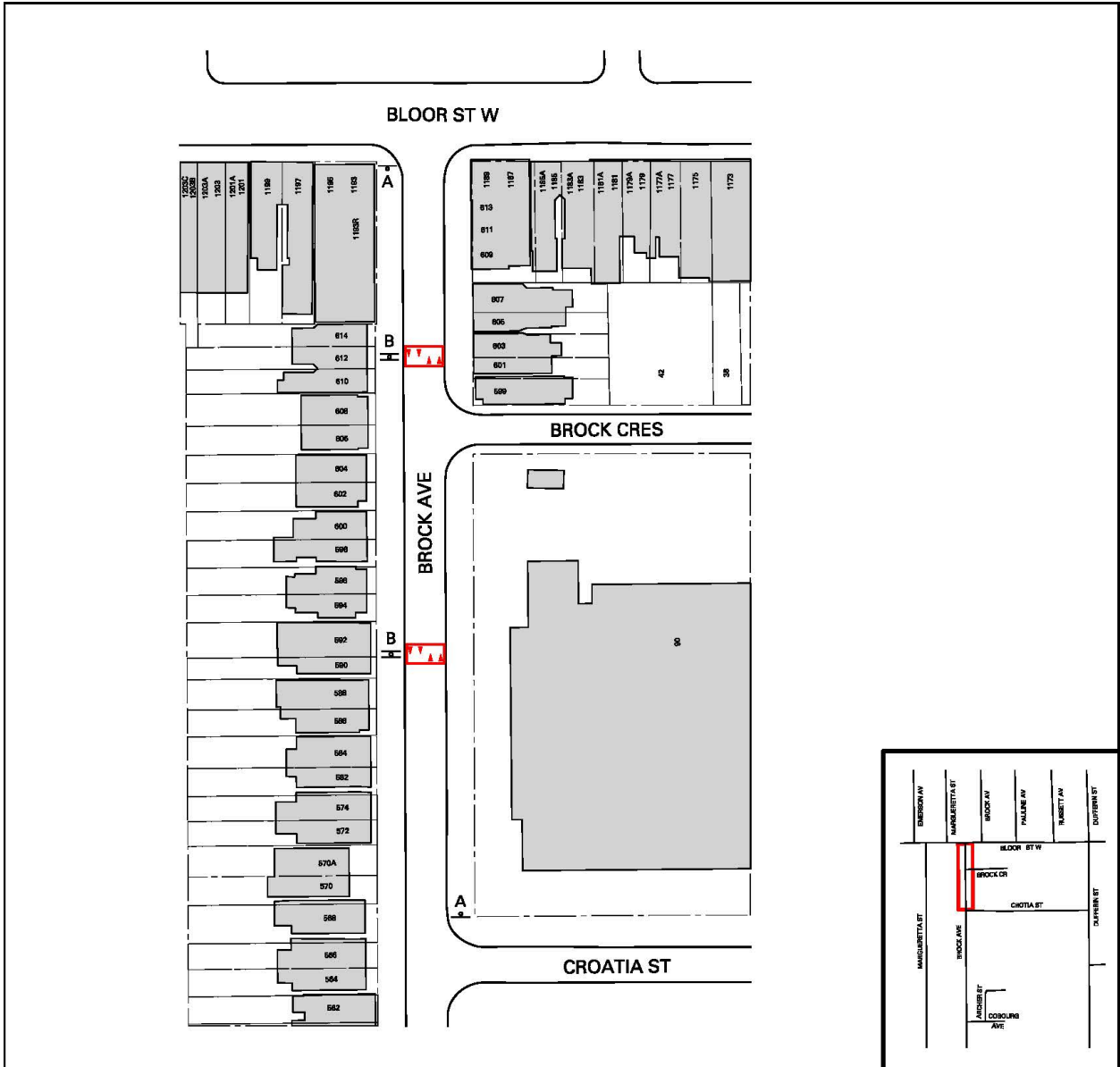
