BY-LAW 378-2022

To authorize the alteration of Balfour Avenue, between Dawes Road and Barrington Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Balfour Avenue, between Dawes Road and Barrington Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

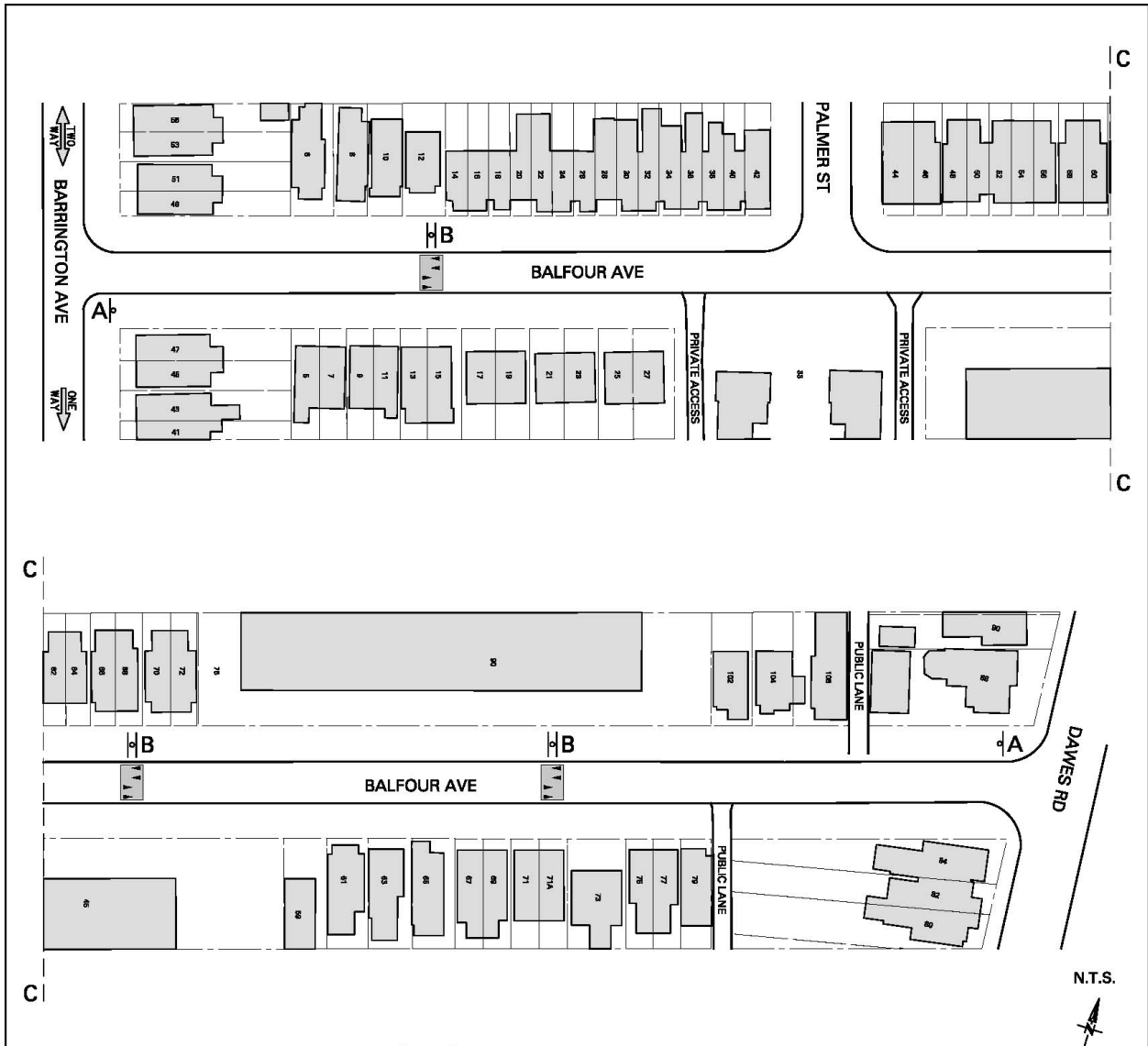
