CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 391-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, respecting Chicory Lane, Staines Road, Morningside Avenue.

Whereas in Section 27-18.4F(1) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Scarborough Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law to designate part or those parts of a private road or roads as a fire route; and

Whereas City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880 provides for the inclusion of locations in the City of Toronto as designated fire routes where such locations meet the requirements of that Chapter; and

Whereas the Fire Chief is satisfied that the locations described below meet the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880 for inclusion of these locations as designated fire routes;

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. That part or those parts of the private road or roads shown on the site plan filed with the Fire Chief in respect of the municipal addresses set out below in this By-law are designated as fire routes pursuant to Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, and Schedule A to Municipal Code Chapter 880 is amended to add the following addresses:
 - (a) 3 to 35 Chicory Lane;
 - (b) Rear of 91 to 119 Staines Road; and
 - (c) Rear of 2131 to 2173 Morningside Avenue;

and include these locations as designated fire routes within the meaning of the By-law.
