BY-LAW 433-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, to suspend certain rules related to statutory hearings for the remainder of the Council term.

Whereas pursuant to Municipal Code Chapter 27-7, Council Procedures, Council may suspend rules in the Procedures By-law and substitute special rules for a defined period of time;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Sections 27-16.2C(1) and 27-16.5D of Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, are suspended until November 14, 2022, in respect of statutory hearing required under the Planning Act for proposed official plan amendments respecting official polices related to parkland dedication and related by-laws under section 42 of the Planning Act, and the following special rules are substituted:
 - (a) The Executive Committee hold any statutory hearing required under the Planning Act for proposed official plan amendments respecting official polices related to parkland dedication and related by-laws under section 42 of the Planning Act.
