

**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 502-2022**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting the speed limit on Fairford Avenue.**

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council on June 22, 2015 adopted as amended Item TE8.1, reducing the speed limits from 40 km/h to 30 km/h on all local roads in the Toronto and East York Community Council area, excluding those roads that bound more than one community council area. However, By-Law 1262-2015, being a by-law " To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting the reduction of the speed limit from 40 km/h to 30 km/h on local roads within the Toronto and East York Community Council boundaries regarding local roads in Ward 30", inadvertently included entries for Fairford Avenue, between Woodfield Road and Coxwell Avenue, reducing the speed limit from 40 km/h to 30 km/h, despite that portion of highway being classified as a Collector Road; and

Whereas pursuant to Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Speed Limit (km/h))
Fairford Avenue	Woodfield Road and Coxwell Avenue	30

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Speed Limit (km/h))
Fairford Avenue	Woodfield Road and Coxwell Avenue	40
