BY-LAW 623-2022

To authorize the alteration of Guestville Avenue, between Lambton Avenue and Eglinton Avenue West, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Guestville Avenue, between Lambton Avenue and Eglinton Avenue West, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Guestville Avenue, between Lambton Avenue and Eglinton Avenue West;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

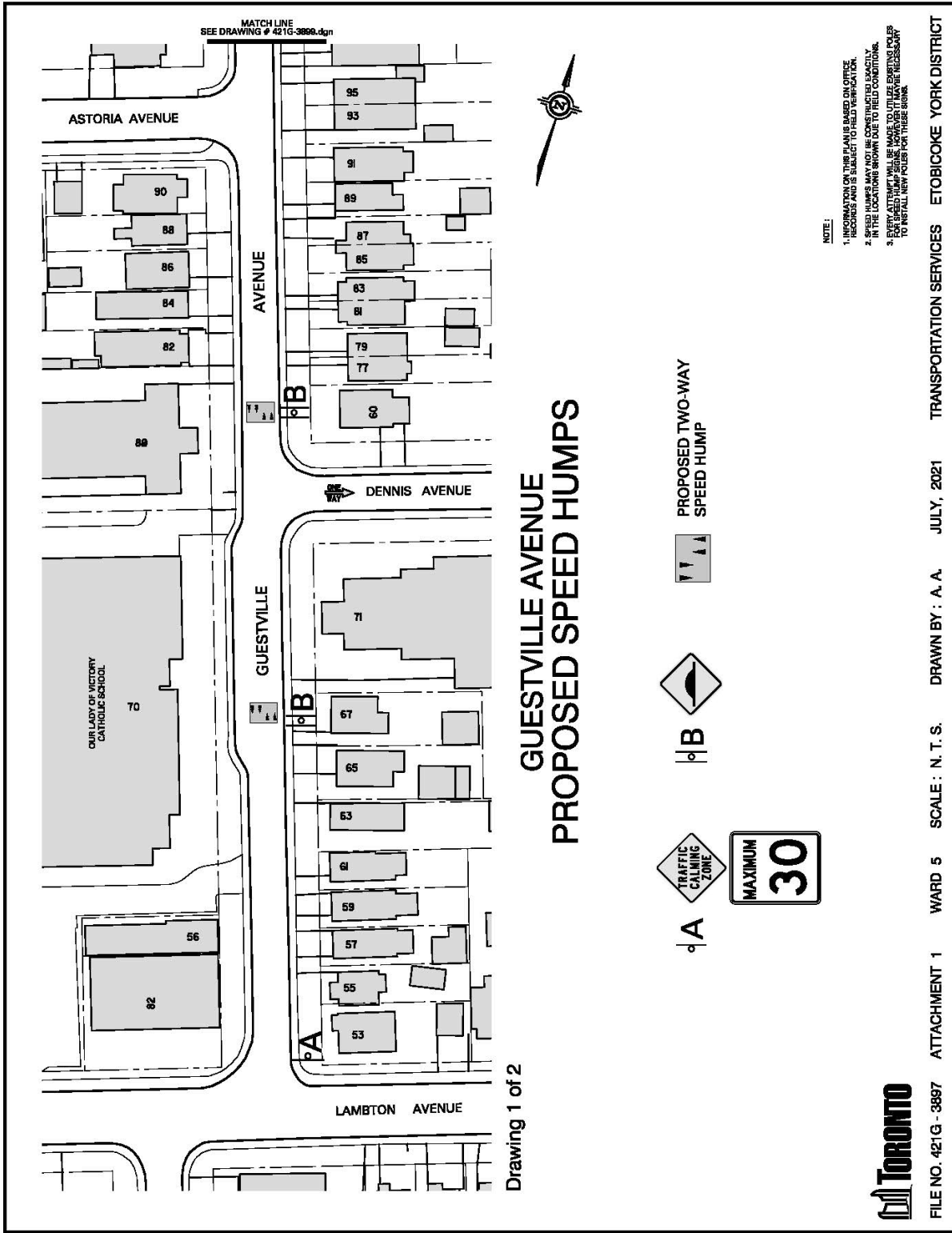
