BY-LAW 758-2022

To authorize the alteration of Firstbrooke Road, between Burgess Avenue and Corley Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Firstbrooke Road, between Burgess Avenue and Corley Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

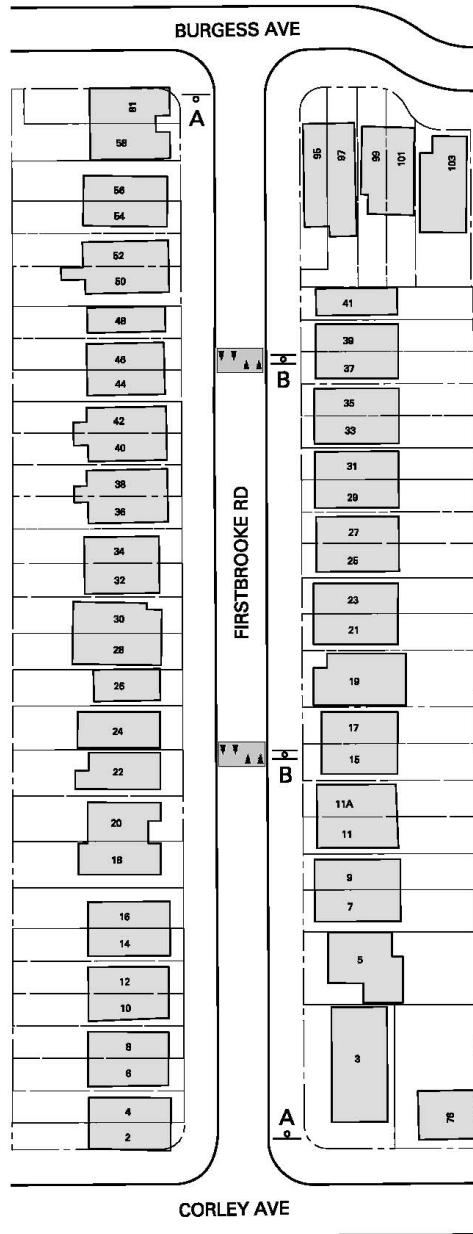


