BY-LAW 766-2022

To authorize the alteration of Scarboro Beach Boulevard, between Queen Street East and Hubbard Boulevard, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Scarboro Beach Boulevard, between Queen Street East and Hubbard Boulevard, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

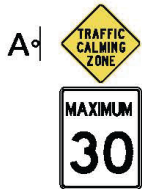
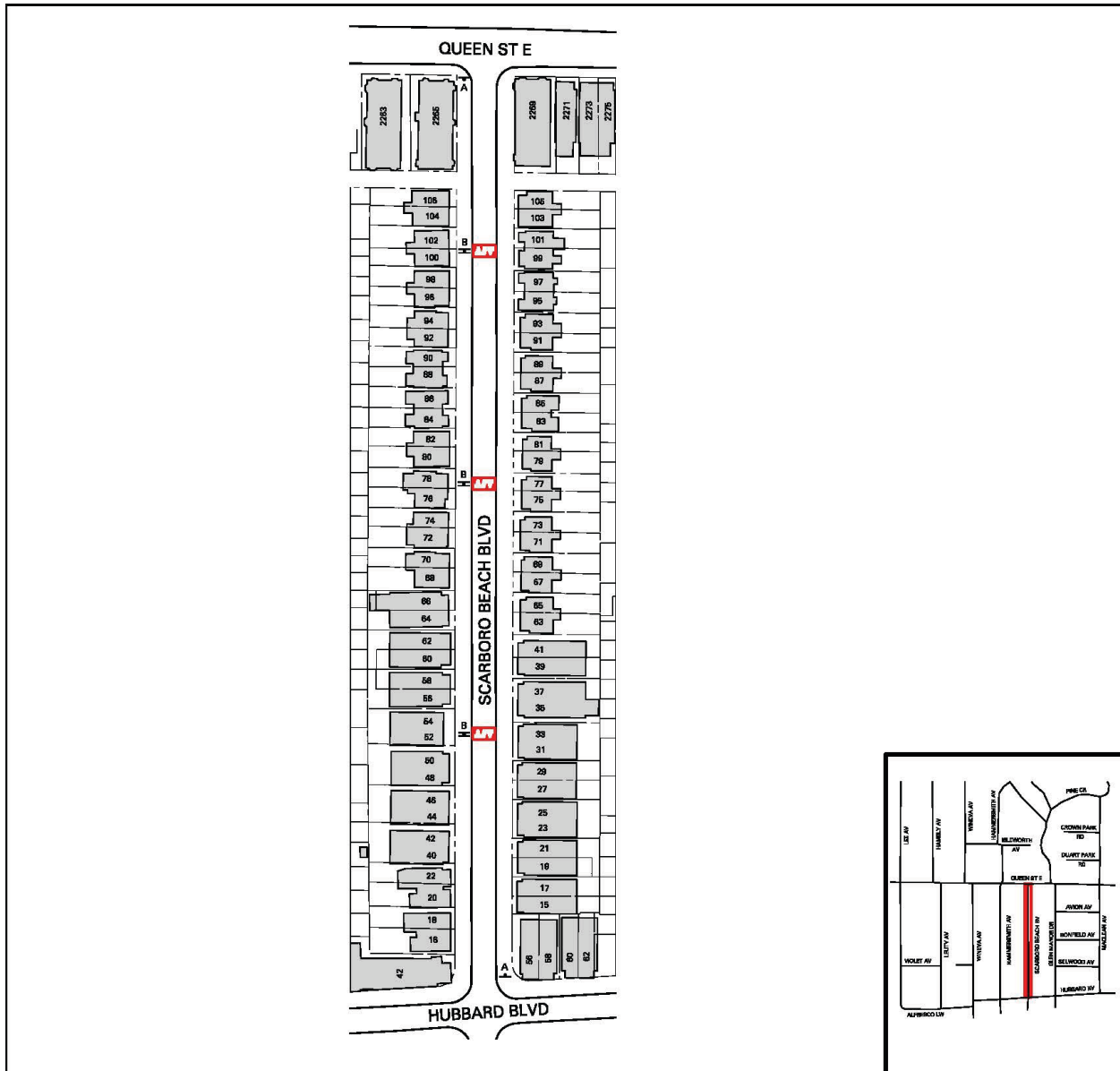
