BY-LAW 768-2022

To authorize the alteration of Scarborough Road, between Queen Street East and Pine Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Scarborough Road, between Queen Street East and Pine Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

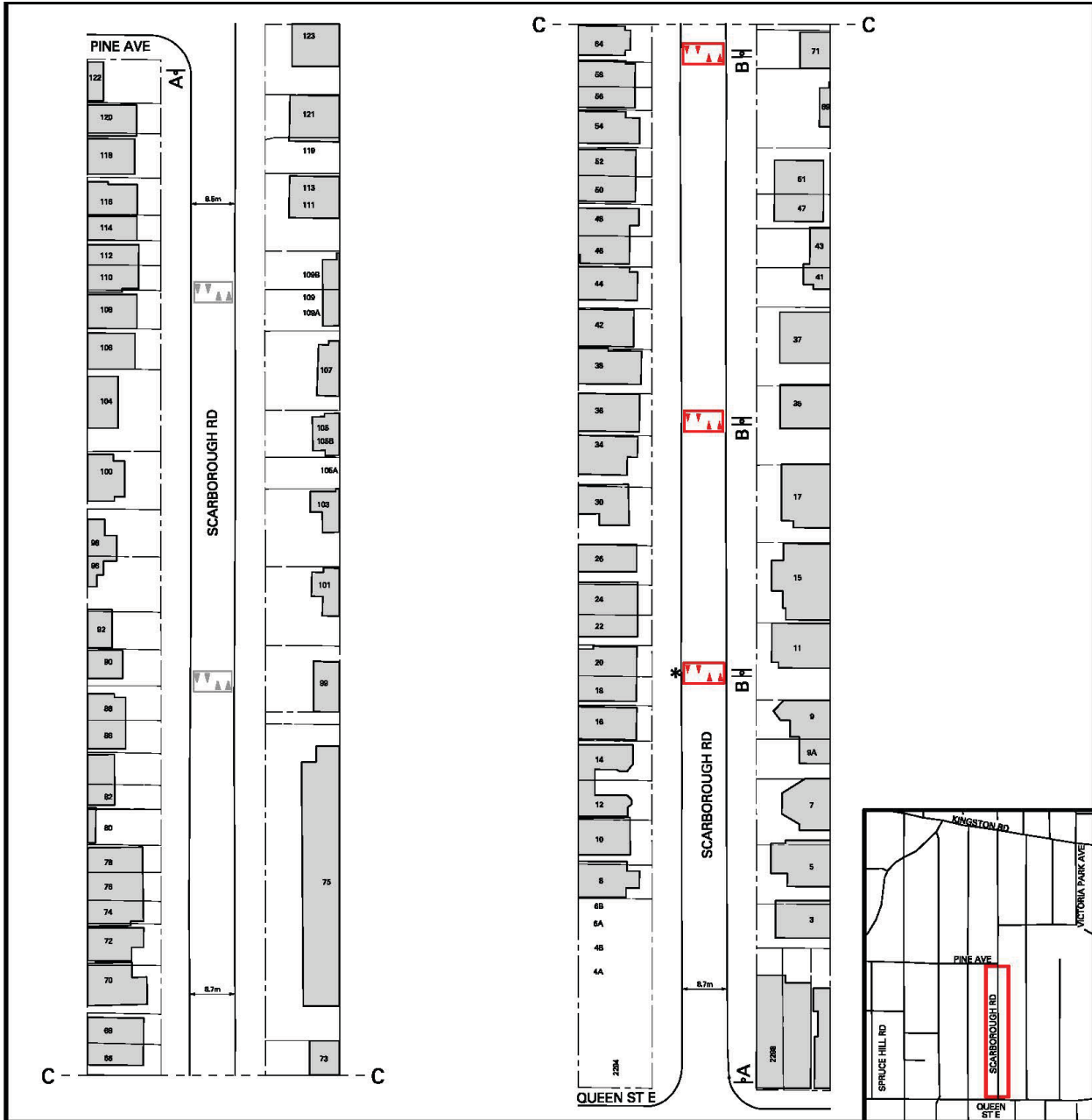
